



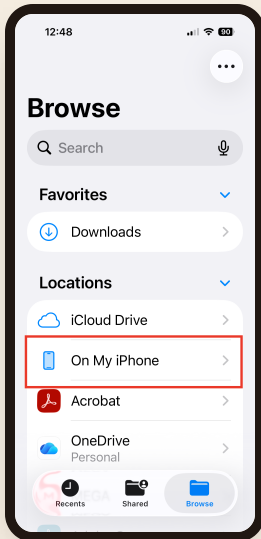
COPPERHOUND • USER GUIDE

Opening the App

on your phone or computer

CopperHound downloads as a single HTML file. This short guide walks you through opening that file in your web browser so you can start cataloging your collection.

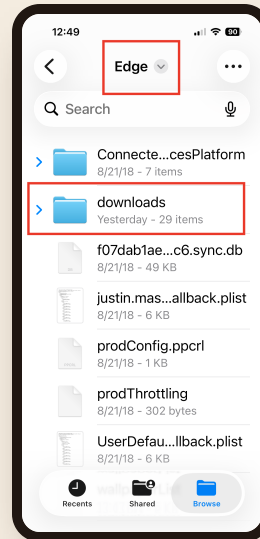
Note: These screenshots show an **iPhone** using the **Microsoft Edge** browser. The taps and screens look a little different on Android, Mac, or PC, and with other browsers (Chrome, Safari, Firefox) — but the idea is the same: find the downloaded file and open it in your browser.



STEP 1

This is the goal: the app open in your browser

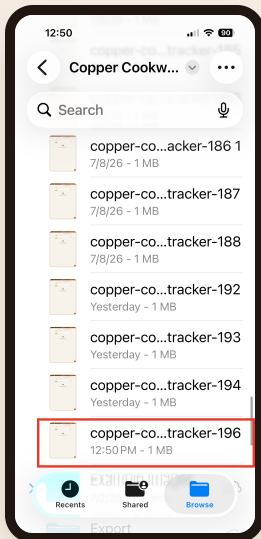
Here's where we're headed. When CopperHound is running, it opens in your web **browser** (notice the address bar at the top). The steps below show how to get here from the downloaded file.



STEP 2

Open the Files app and go to On My iPhone

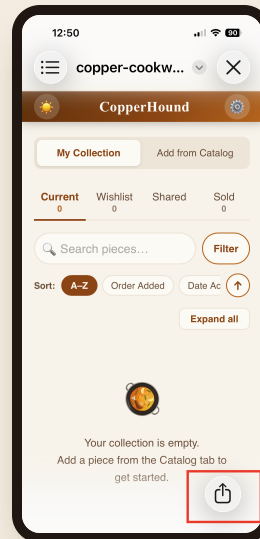
Open the **Files** app, tap **Browse**, then under **Locations** tap **On My iPhone**. This is where files saved to your phone live.



STEP 3

Open your browser's Downloads folder

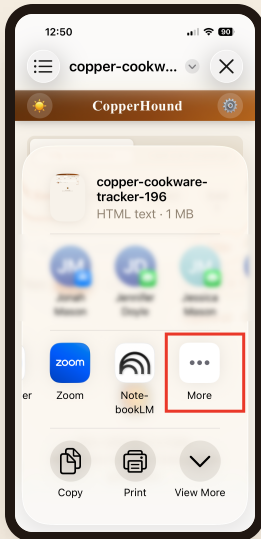
Open the folder for the browser you downloaded with — here it's **Edge** — then open the **downloads** folder inside it.



STEP 4

Find the file and tap it

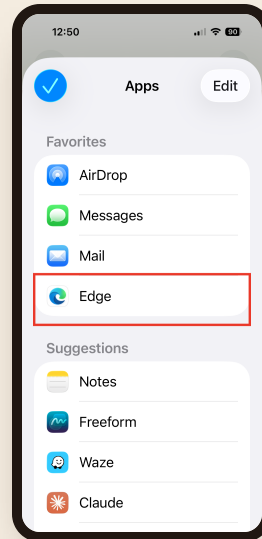
Tap the file named **copper-cookware-tracker** (it may end in a version number like **-196**). The newest one has the most recent date.



STEP 5

Tap the Share button

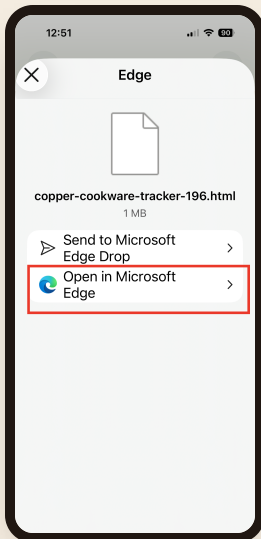
The file opens in a **preview** — not the running app yet. Tap the **Share** button (the square with an up arrow) to open it in a browser.



STEP 6

Tap “More” to find your browser

In the share menu, if your browser isn't shown in the first row, tap **More** to see the full list of apps you can open the file with.



STEP 7

Choose your browser

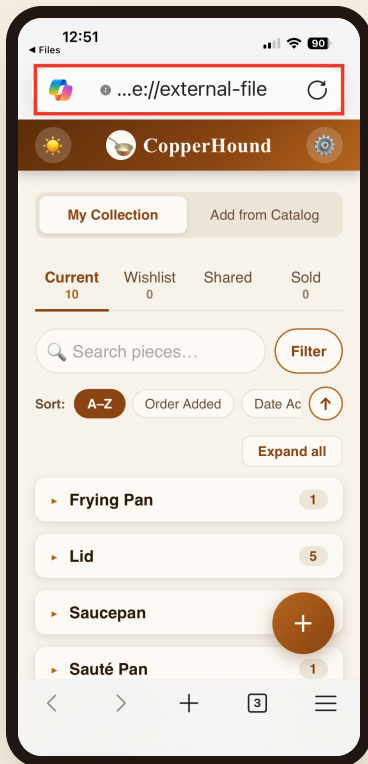
Pick the browser you want to use — here, **Edge**. **Use the same browser every time**, since CopperHound saves your collection inside that browser.



LAST STEP

Open it in the browser

Some browsers add one more tap. Choose **Open in Microsoft Edge** (or your browser's “open” option). The browser then launches and loads CopperHound — ready to use, just like the very first screenshot in this guide.



A few things to remember

- 1 **Remember where you saved the file.** If you close the browser tab, just repeat these steps to open the same file again.
- ! **Always use the same browser.** CopperHound saves your collection inside the browser you open it with. Use Edge once and Chrome next, and your collection won't appear — each browser keeps its own separate data.
- ✓ **Back up now and then.** Use the export option in the app to save a copy of your collection, so your records are safe even if browser data is cleared.
